PURSUANT to the Wool Proceeds Retention Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Wool Proceeds Retention Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wool Proceeds Retention Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
2. Regulations 13 to 15 of the principal regulations are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations revoke the parts of the Wool Proceeds Retention Regulations 1950 that provided for the registration of dealers in wool, and required them to supply particulars of their purchases to the Department of Agriculture.
