THE WHITEBAIT REGULATIONS 1932, AMENDMENT NO. 7.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 22nd day of
October, 1941.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Whitebait Regulations 1932, Amendment No. 7.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Whitebait Regulations 1932* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

4. Regulation 24 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following paragraph thereto :—

“(3) That part of the Grey River below the Cobden Bridge and any tributary waters or lagoons draining into the Grey River at any point between the Cobden Bridge and the mouth of the said river.”
