Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Whitebait Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Whitebait Regulations 1947* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (c) of clause (2).
- 3. Regulation 31 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "Styx", the words "Cam, Kaiapoi".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

Regulation 2 revokes the prohibition on whitebait fishing in the Boyne Creek and all that portion of the Saltwater Creek above its confluence with Boyne Creek.

The effect of regulation 3 is to permit the use of boats for whitebait fishing in the Rivers Cam and Kaiapoi.
