**THE WHITEBAIT REGULATIONS 1947, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

---

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Whitebait Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Whitebait Regulations 1947\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (c) of clause (2).

3. Regulation 31 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "Styx", the words "Cam, Kaiapoi".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]*

Regulation 2 revokes the prohibition on whitebait fishing in the Boyne Creek and all that portion of the Saltwater Creek above its confluence with Boyne Creek.

The effect of regulation 3 is to permit the use of boats for whitebait fishing in the Rivers Cam and Kaiapoi.
