ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 23rd day of July 1979

Present:

THE HON. D. MACINTYRE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 72 (2A) of the Wildlife Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wildlife Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wildlife Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Penalties for offences relating to pollution—Regulation 43A of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Wildlife Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 6) is hereby amended by adding the following subclause:

“(3) Every person who contravenes subclause (1) of this regulation commits an offence, and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$2,000 and, if the offence is a continuing one, to a further fine not exceeding \$20 for every day during which the offence continues.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe the penalties payable in respect of the offence of polluting waters, where the pollution is likely to be injurious to wildlife or to the food of wildlife.
