## THE WILDLIFE REGULATIONS 1955, AMENDMENT NO. 8

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 12th day of March 1973

Present:

THE HON. A. J. FAULKNER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wildlife Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wildlife Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wildlife Regulations 1955\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. **Licence fees**—Regulation 13 (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Wildlife Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 2, and amended by section 7 of the Decimal Currency Act 1964), is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (1) the expression “\$6”, and substituting the expression “\$10”.
