PURSUANT to the Wildlife Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wildlife Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wildlife Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Licence fees—Regulation 13 (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Wildlife Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 2, and amended by section 7 of the Decimal Currency Act 1964), is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (1) the expression "\$6", and substituting the expression "\$10".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The maximum licence fee that may be fixed for a licence issued under the regulations is increased from \$6 to \$10.
