



**THE WORKING RAILWAYS ACCOUNT REGULATIONS 1935,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 24th day of
March, 1943.

Present :

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 40 of the Government Railways Act, 1926,
His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice
and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following
regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Working Railways
Account Regulations 1935, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of
the regulations made under the Government Railways Act, 1926, on
the 3rd day of December, 1935* (hereinafter called the principal
regulations).

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on
the 1st day of April, 1942.

4. The principal regulations may hereafter be cited as the Working
Railways Account Regulations 1935.

5. Clause 1 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting
the words " and one-quarter ".

6. Clause 3 of the principal regulations is amended :—

(1) By revoking subclause (a) (ii), and substituting the following
subclause—

" (ii) The amount of moneys expended (including any
imprest advances) as shown by the Treasury accounts, down
to the last day of every month in respect of the vote of the
Public Works Fund called ' Railways Improvements and
Additions to Open Lines ' Vote during the period from and
including the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred
and thirty-one, to and including the thirty-first day of
March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, and in
respect of the vote of the Working Railways Account called
' Railways Improvements and Additions to Open Lines '
Vote on and after the first day of April, one thousand nine
hundred and forty-two."

- (2) By revoking subclause (b), and substituting the following subclause—

“(b) The total amount of capital moneys expended in respect of the railways determined in the manner prescribed by paragraph (a) of this clause shall be reduced by the amount of any moneys lawfully paid during the period from and including the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, to and including the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, from the Working Railways Account, down to the last day of every month to the ‘ Railways Improvements and Additions to Open Lines ’ Vote of the Public Works Fund and on and after the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, from the Working Railways Account, down to the last day of every month to the ‘ Railways Improvements and Additions to Open Lines ’ Vote of the Working Railways Account, in respect of the cost of assets worn out, abandoned, destroyed, or obsolete in the service of the Railways Department.”
