Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 April 2002, disestablishes the Wanganui Regional Community Polytechnic and incorporates it into Universal College of Learning (or UCOL – the Manawatu Polytechnic as renamed, under section 162(5) of the Education Act 1989, by a notice published in the *Gazette* on 21 September 2000). (For provisions on the effect of the disestablishment and incorporation into the other institution, *see* sections 217 and 218 of the Act.)
