PURSUANT to section 1 (2) of the Waikato Raupatu Claims Settlement Act 1995, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Waikato Raupatu Claims Settlement Act Commencement Order 1996.

2. Commencement of section 32 (1) of Waikato Raupatu Claims Settlement Act 1995—Section 32 (1) of the Waikato Raupatu Claims Settlement Act 1995 shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1996.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, on 1 November 1996, section 32 (1) of the Waikato Raupatu Claims Settlement Act 1995. That section substitutes a new section 42L in the Transit New Zealand Act 1989 which requires consultation with Maori interests before any output or capital project is included in certain roading programmes.
