PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Waiheke Road District Foreshore Licence Order 1962, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Waiheke Road District Foreshore Licence Order 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Foreshore licence—Clause 3 of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the expression “M.D. 4496”, and substituting the expression “M.D. 13460”.
