



THE WHEAT RESEARCH LEVY NOTICE 1986

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Wheat Research Levy Act 1974, the Minister of Science and Technology hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Wheat Research Levy Notice 1986.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1986.

2. Levies—The following levies are hereby imposed, namely,—

- (a) On each producer of wheat grown in New Zealand and sold or delivered to a flourmiller or to a grain merchant, a levy computed at the rate of 50 cents for every tonne of wheat so sold or delivered by that producer while this notice is in force:
- (b) On each person who carries on business as a flourmiller, a levy computed at the rate of \$1.30 for every tonne of flour or wheatmeal delivered by him from his flourmill while this notice is in force:
- (c) On each purchaser or other person who takes delivery of flour or wheatmeal from a flourmill while this notice is in force, a levy computed at the rate of \$1.30 for every tonne of that flour or wheatmeal.

3. Revocation—The Wheat Research Levy Notice 1984* is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 February 1986, increases the rate of one of the levies imposed to provide funds for wheat research.

The levy payable in respect of wheat is increased from 18 cents to 50 cents per tonne.

The levy payable in respect of flour and wheatmeal remains at \$1.30 per tonne.
