## THE WHEAT RESEARCH REGULATIONS 1954, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to section 17 of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Wheat Research Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wheat Research Regulations 1954\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) There regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1962.
- 2. (1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Wheat Research Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended as follows:
  - (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the words "rate of 4d.", and substituting the words "rate of 5d.":

  - (c) By omitting from paragraph (c) the words "rate of 4d.", and substituting the words "rate of 5d.".
- (2) The Wheat Research Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase, from 4d. to 5d., the rates of levy imposed on producers, flourmillers, and bakers in respect of wheat research.
