ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of December 1966

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 17 of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Wheat Research Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wheat Research Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 5, the following regulation:
- "5A. Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 5 of these regulations, any flourmiller or grain merchant may deduct from any levy collected by him under paragraph (a) of that regulation a collection fee of an amount equal to $2\frac{1}{2}$ percent of the levy before he pays the proceeds of the levy into the Public Account."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Wheat Research Regulations 1966 so that flourmillers and grain merchants who collect levies payable under those regulations by producers of wheat, by deducting the amount of the levy from the price paid for the wheat, may deduct a collection fee equal to $2\frac{1}{2}$ percent of the levy before they pay the proceeds of the levy into the Public Account.
