HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 17 of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wheat Research Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wheat Research Regulations 1966\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1972.

**2. Levies increased**—(1) Regulation 4 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Wheat Research Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the figure “7c” wherever it occurs, and substituting in each case the figure “10c”.

(2) The Wheat Research Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 2, are hereby repealed.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase, from 7 cents to 10 cents, the rate of levy imposed in respect of wheat research. The new rate comes into force on 1 January 1972.
