**THE WESTERN SAMOA AUDIT REGULATIONS 1948,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Samoa Act 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Western Samoa Audit Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Western Samoa Audit Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 33 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following additional proviso :—

“ Provided also that the Minister may by writing under his hand delegate to the Secretary to the Government of Western Samoa the powers exercisable by him under this regulation, either generally or in relation to any particular case, and subject to such restrictions and conditions (if any) as the Minister thinks fit, and every such delegation shall be revocable at will, but unless and until revoked shall continue in force according to its tenor, notwithstanding the fact that the Minister by whom it was made or the Secretary to whom it was made may have ceased to hold office, and in any such case every such delegation shall continue in force as if made by or to the successor in office of the Minister or the Secretary to the Government of Western Samoa, as the case may be.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations amend the Western Samoa Audit Regulations 1948 so as to enable the Minister of Island Territories to delegate to the Secretary to the Government of Western Samoa the Minister's power under regulation 33 of ordering that payments be allowed by the Audit Office without production of vouchers in cases where the papers have been lost or destroyed.
