HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Public Safety Conservation Act, 1932, there being a Proclamation of Emergency now in force under that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Waterfront Strike Emergency Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Waterfront Strike Emergency Regulations 1951\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following additional subclause:—
- "(11) All funds, rights, powers, and remedies vested in any Receiver by this regulation shall be held by the Receiver upon trust to retain the same until Parliament makes provision for the disposal thereof."
