At the Government House at Wellington, this 12th day of November, 1947

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the War Service Gratuities Emergency Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the War Service Gratuities Emergency Regulations 1945* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words "On the 31st day of March at or next following the end of the first, second, and third years from the date of entitlement ", and substituting the words " On the first, second, and third anniversaries of the date of entitlement ".

(2) In respect of any War Gratuity Post Office Savings-bank Accounts that have been closed before the commencement of these regulations, but not earlier than the first anniversary of the date of entitlement, bonuses shall be payable under the said Regulation 11, as amended by this regulation, as if this regulation had been in force when the accounts were closed.
