Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the War Service Gratuities Emergency Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the War Service Gratuities Emergency Regulations 1945* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations (as substituted by Regulation 3 of the War Service Gratuities Emergency Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) By omitting the words "within three years thereafter", and substituting the words "at any time thereafter":
 - (b) By omitting from the proviso to paragraph (b) the words "within three years from", and substituting the words "at any time after":
 - (c) By omitting from the proviso to paragraph (c) the words "on any subsequent date within three years from ", and substituting the words "at any time after".
- 3. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations (as substituted by Regulation 3 of the War Service Gratuities Emergency Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words "or within three years thereafter".
