Pursuant to the Samoa Act, 1921, and the Samoa Amendment Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Western Samoa Legislative Assembly Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Western Samoa Legislative Assembly Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (c) the words "imprisonment for a term of one year or upwards", and substituting the words "imprisonment for a term of two years or upwards".
- **3.** Regulation 18 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (c) the words "imprisonment for a term of one year or upwards", and substituting the words "imprisonment for a term of two years or upwards".
