ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 117 of the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Water Supplies Protection Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Water Supplies Protection Regulations 1961\*.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1985.

**2. Hospital appliances**—Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “Hospital Board”, and substituting the words “area health board, hospital board,”.
