**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 2nd day of May 1966

**Present:**

**THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 57 of the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1.** These regulations may be cited as the Wellington Secondary Schools Regulations 1966.

**2.** The regulations shall apply to the following schools, namely—

- (a) Wellington College:
- (b) Wellington Girls College:
- (c) Rongotai College:
- (d) Wellington East Girls College:
- (e) Onslow College:
- (f) Wellington High School.

**3.** (1) For the purposes of section 57 of the Education Act 1964, there shall be, in respect of the schools to which these regulations apply, a Secondary Schools Council which shall be called the Wellington Secondary Schools Council.

(2) The Wellington Secondary Schools Council is hereby declared to be the same council as the Wellington Post-primary Schools Council existing immediately before the commencement of these regulations under the Wellington Post-primary Schools Regulations 1956\*.

**4.** The Board of Governors of Wellington College shall consist of:

- (a) One Governor appointed by the Wellington Education Board:

5. The Board of Governors of Wellington Girls College shall consist of:
- (a) One Governor appointed by the Wellington Education Board:
  - (b) One Governor appointed by the Wellington City Council:
  - (c) One Governor appointed by the Council of the Victoria University of Wellington:
  - (d) One Governor appointed by the Old Pupils Association of the school:
  - (e) Five Governors elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school:
  - (f) One Governor co-opted by the Board of Governors itself, if and when it thinks fit.
6. The Board of Governors of Rongotai College shall consist of:
- (a) One Governor appointed by the Wellington Education Board:
  - (b) One Governor appointed by the Wellington City Council:
  - (c) One Governor appointed by the Council of the Victoria University of Wellington:
  - (d) Two Governors appointed by the Old Pupils Association of the school:
  - (e) Five Governors elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school.
7. The Board of Governors of Wellington East Girls College shall consist of:
- (a) One Governor appointed by the Wellington Education Board:
  - (b) One Governor appointed by the Council of the Victoria University of Wellington:
  - (c) One Governor appointed by the Old Pupils Association of the school:
  - (d) Six Governors elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school:
  - (e) One Governor co-opted by the Board of Governors itself, if and when it thinks fit.
8. The Board of Governors of Onslow College shall consist of:
- (a) One Governor appointed by the Wellington Education Board:
  - (b) One Governor appointed by the Council of the Victoria University of Wellington:
  - (c) Five Governors elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school:
  - (d) Two Governors elected by the members of the school committees of the Johnsonville State Primary School, the Johnsonville West State Primary School, the Khandallah State Primary School, the Newlands State Primary School, the Ngaio State Primary School, and Ohariu Valley State Primary School:
- Provided that the Minister of Education may from time to time, by notice in the *Gazette*, amend the list of schools to which this paragraph applies.

9. (1) The Board of Governors of Wellington High School shall consist of:

- (a) One Governor appointed by the Wellington Education Board:
- (b) One Governor appointed by the Wellington City Council:
- (c) One Governor appointed by the Council of the Victoria University of Wellington:
- (d) Five Governors elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school:
- (e) One Governor appointed by the associations of employers in local industries:
- (f) One Governor appointed by the associations of employees in local industries:
- (g) One Governor to be co-opted by the Board of Governors itself, if and when it thinks fit.

(2) The Wellington High School Board of Managers Order 1964\* is hereby revoked.

10. The regulations specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.
