



**THE WELLINGTON SECONDARY SCHOOLS REGULATIONS
1966, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of August 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 57 (11) of the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wellington Secondary Schools Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wellington Secondary Schools Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1979.

2. Onslow College—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 8, and substituting the following regulation:

“8. The Board of Governors of Onslow College shall comprise:

“(a) One member appointed by the Wellington Education Board:

“(b) One member appointed by the Council of the Victoria University of Wellington:

“(c) Six members elected by the parents of pupils attending Onslow College:

“(d) One member appointed by the school committee of Raroa Normal Intermediate School:

“(e) If the Board thinks fit, one member appointed by it.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 June 1979, change the constitution of the Board of Governors of Onslow College by increasing from 5 to 6 the number of parent representatives, substituting for the 2 members elected by the parents of pupils at certain primary schools one member elected by the parents of pupils attending Raroa Normal Intermediate School, and authorising the Board to co-opt one member.
