PURSUANT to section 1 (3) of the Wool Testing Authority Dissolution Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Wool Testing Authority Dissolution Act Commencement Order 1988.

2. Commencement of sections—Sections 17 to 26 of, and the Second Schedule to, the Wool Testing Authority Dissolution Act 1988 shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1989.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order appoints 1 January 1989 as the day on which sections 17 to 26 of, and the Second Schedule to, the Wool Testing Authority Dissolution Act 1988 come into force.

As from the commencement of that day,—

- (a) The Wool Testing Authority is dissolved; and
- (b) Certain leasehold interests in land vest in the Crown; and
- (c) The undertaking of the Wool Testing Authority (apart from those leasehold interests) vests in Fibre Testing Laboratories Limited.
