



Zoological Gardens Amendment Regulations 2001

Pursuant to section 160(1)(b) of the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Zoological Gardens Amendment Regulations 2001.
- (2) In these regulations the Zoological Gardens Regulations 1977¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3 New regulation 1A inserted

The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 1, the following regulation:

“1A Regulations to continue in force until 28 July 2003

Despite section 152(1) and (4) of the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996, these regulations continue in force under section 152(3) of that Act and are to be treated as having effect until the close of 28 July 2003, at which time they expire.”

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which are made under section 160 of the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996, amend the Zoological Gardens Regulations 1977 to extend their operation until 28 July 2003. The regulations would otherwise expire on 29 July 2001.
