IN THE TWENTY-SEVENTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF HER MAJESTY
QUEEN VICTORIA.

AN ORDINANCE *to Indemnify the Superintendent of the Province of Otago against and on account of Expenditure during the year ending on the 31st day of March, 1864, in excess of Appropriation.* Title.

WHEREAS by the "Appropriation Ordinance, 1863-4" it is Preamble. enacted that out of the Revenue of the said Province there might be issued and applied for defraying the charge of the Government of the said Province for the twelve months ending on the thirty-first day of March last any sums of money not exceeding the several sums for the several purposes in the first Schedule in the said Ordinance specified : And whereas the actual expenditure of the said Government during the said year for and in respect of several of the purposes and matters specified in the said Schedule has exceeded the sums by the said Ordinance authorised to be issued and applied by the sum of thirty-eight thousand and seventy-three pounds three shillings as is more particularly specified and shewn in the Schedule hereinafter contained and numbered I. And whereas by the third Section of the said Ordinance it is also enacted that out of the sum of fifty thousand pounds authorised to be raised by the "Otago Loan Ordinance, 1861" and the "Otago Loan Ordinance, 1861-2" there should and might be issued and applied the sum of six thousand nine hundred and fifty pounds to

be appropriated towards or for the services in the said third Section mentioned: And whereas the actual expenditure of the said Government during the said year for and in respect of divers of the services specified in the said third Section has exceeded in the whole the sums by the said third Section authorised to be issued and thereby appropriated to the said last mentioned services by the sum of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five pounds as is more particularly specified and shewn in the Schedule hereinafter contained and numbered II: And whereas by the fourth Section of the said Ordinance it is also enacted that out of the sum of fifty thousand pounds authorised to be raised by the "Otago Public Buildings Loan Ordinance, 1862" there should and might be issued and applied the sum of twenty-eight thousand one hundred and fifty pounds to be appropriated towards or for the several services in the said fourth Section specified: And whereas the actual expenditure of the said Government during the said year for and in respect of divers of the last mentioned services has exceeded in the whole the sums in and by the said fourth Section authorised to be issued and thereby appropriated to the said services respectively by the sum of ninety-three pounds as is more particularly specified and shewn in the Schedule hereinafter contained and numbered III: And whereas by the fifth Section of the said Ordinance it is also enacted that out of the sum of five hundred thousand pounds authorised to be raised by the "Otago Loan Ordinance, 1862" there should and might be issued and applied the sum of four hundred and ninety-four thousand nine hundred and forty-seven pounds thirteen shillings and elevenpence to be appropriated towards or for the services in the said fifth Section specified: And whereas the actual expenditure of the said Government during the said year for and in respect of divers of the said last mentioned services has exceeded in the whole the several sums in and by the said fifth Section authorised to be issued and thereby appropriated to the said services by the sum of thirty-one thousand seven hundred and fifty-eight pounds two shillings as is more particularly specified and shewn in the Schedule hereinafter contained and numbered IV: And whereas the expenditure of the said sums of thirty-eight thousand and seventy-three pounds three shillings and one thousand eight hundred and fifth-five pounds and ninety-three pounds and thirty-one thousand seven hundred and fifty-eight pounds two shillings the items whereof are respectively specified and shewn in the Schedules hereinafter contained and numbered I, II, III, and IV, respectively was reasonable and necessary and it is expedient to indemnify the Superintendent for and against the said expenditure of the said four several sums of money:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Otago with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited and referred to as the "Superintendent's Indemnity Ordinance, 1864."

2. The Superintendent of the Province of Otago is hereby indemnified for and against the expenditure of the said four several sums of money of £38,073 3s. and £1,855 and £93 and £ 31,758 2s. for the government of the said Province and for Public Works and undertakings within the said Province during the twelve months ending on the thirty-first day of March last in excess of the sums authorised by the "Appropriation Ordinance, 1863-4" the items of which expenditure are specified in the four Schedules hereunto annexed and the Superintendent is also hereby indemnified for and against the issue of warrants to the Treasurer of the said Province for the said several sums of £38,073 3s. and £1,855 and £93 and £31,758 2s. respectively : And the Provincial Treasurer is hereby allowed and is authorised to take credit in his accounts for the said sums so expended in excess and for which the said warrants have been issued by the said Superintendent.
