AN ORDINANCE to constitute the Superintendent of the Province of
Otago a Corporation for certain purposes.

WHEREAS the Superintendent of the Province of Otago has Preamble.
already purchased and it may be necessary for the Super-
intendent of the said Province hereafter to purchase or otherwise
acquire lands within the said Province for the public purposes of
the said Province:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province
of Otago with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council
thereof as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Ordinance shall be “The Superin- Short Title.
tendent’s Incorporation Ordinance 1863.”

2. The Superintendent of the Province of Otago and his suc- Superintendent con-
stituted a Corporation.
cessors shall as to all land heretofore and hereafter to be conveyed
or assigned to him or them for any public purpose be held and
taken to be a Body Corporate under the name of the Superintendent
of Otago and by that name have perpetual succession and be ca-
pable in law to do and suffer in respect of any lands vested in him
as aforesaid whatever may lawfully be done and suffered by a Body
Corporate.

Management and administration of lands.

3. All lands vested in the Superintendent as aforesaid shall be under the management and administration of the said Superintendent by and with the advice and consent of his Executive Council who shall be entitled to lease the same from time to time for any term not exceeding three years.

Lands not to be sold or mortgaged.

4. No lands vested as aforesaid shall be sold or mortgaged or leased for a longer period than three years except by the authority of the Provincial Council of the Province of Otago by Ordinance passed in that behalf.

Not to apply to certain lands.

5. This Ordinance shall not apply to any land vested or to become vested in the said Superintendent and his successors by any existing or future Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand.
