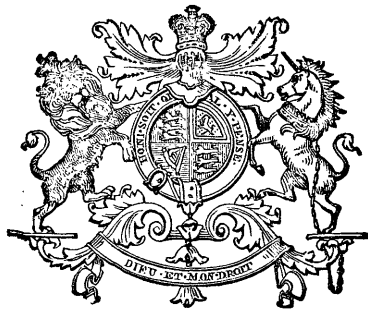

AN ORDINANCE *to amend an Ordinance intituled "An Ordinance for the better prevention and punishment of Vagrancy and other Offences."*

WHEREAS an Ordinance was passed by the Superintendent Preamble.  
and Provincial Council of the Province of Otago in the  
twenty-fifth year of the reign of Her present Majesty intituled  
"An Ordinance for the better prevention and punishment of  
Vagrancy and other offences." And whereas it is expedient to

repeal clause 11 of the said Ordinance in so far as it interferes with the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court and is otherwise inoperative:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Superintendent of the Province of Otago by and with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof as follows:—

Repeal in part of  
clause 11 of the  
Vagrant Ordinance,  
1861.

1. Clause 11 of the said recited Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed except in so far as it enacts that all proceedings under the said Ordinance shall be had and taken in a summary way.

Short title.

2. The short title of this Ordinance shall be "The Vagrant Ordinance Amendment Ordinance 1862."
