An Act to amend the District Courts Act 1947

1 Short Title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the District Courts Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the District Courts Act 1947 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

This Act is administered by the Ministry of Justice.

- (2) Except as provided in sections 2(7), 6(2), 7(3), 8(2), 9(2), 10(2), 11(3), 12(3), 13(4), 14(2), 15(2), 16(2), 17(2), 19(3), 21(2), 22(3), and 24(2) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1991.

25 Transitional provision

Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e) of section 28A(1) of the principal Act (as substituted by section 4 of this Act), a Court shall not have jurisdiction under Part 2A of the principal Act to try any person for any offence referred to in Part 1 or Part 2 of Schedule 1A to that Act if that person was committed for trial for that offence before the date of commencement of section 4 of this Act.
