The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Domestic Violence Amendment Act 2003.
- (2) In this Act, the Domestic Violence Act 1995 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
