This Act is administered by the Ministry of Education.

1 Short Title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act (No 4) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- (2) Except as provided in sections 5(5), 16(2), 17(2), 18(2), and 34 of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1992.

3 Foreign students

- (1) This subsection substituted section 4, and inserted sections 4A to 4D, of the principal Act.
- (2) This subsection amended the definition of the term **exempt student** in section 2(1) of the principal Act.
- (3) The following enactments are hereby consequentially repealed:
 - (a) Sections 4(1), and 5(2) of the Education Amendment Act 1989:
 - (b) Section 5(2) of the Education Amendment Act (No 2) 1991.
- (4) There shall be deemed to have been set under section 4D(1) of the principal Act (as substituted by subsection (1) of this section) the fee of \$450 per student to be paid by Boards in respect of foreign students enrolled at state schools in 1992.

 - (b) On or after turning 15, and before the commencement of this subsection, ceased to be enrolled at a state school; and
 - (c) Has not since that commencement again enrolled at a state school,—as if that person has turned 16.
- (5) Subsections (1) to (3) of this section shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1993.
