The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Judicature Amendment Act 2012.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the Judicature Act 1908.

4 Associate Judge may exercise certain powers of the court

- (1) Section 26I(1) is amended by repealing paragraph (b).
- (2) Section 26I(2)(e) is amended by omitting “and Part 16” and substituting “Part 16, and section 329”.
