The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Securities Amendment Act 2007.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the Securities Act 1978.

4 Interpretation

Paragraph (a) of the definition of Registrar in section 2(1) is amended by omitting “sections 7 and 67” and substituting “sections 67A to 68B, 68G, 68I, and 68K”.

5 Civil liability for breach of contributory mortgage regulations

Section 57A(2)(c) is amended by omitting “District Registrar of Companies at Wellington” and substituting “Registrar”.
