The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2002.
- (2) In this Act, the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Variation, suspension, or cancellation of licences other than special licences

- (1) Section 132(1)(a) of the principal Act is amended by inserting, after the word “Authority”, the words “or a District Licensing Agency”.
- (2) Section 132(6)(a) of the principal Act is amended by inserting, after the word “Authority”, the words “or a District Licensing Agency”.
