The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2004 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act is deemed to have come into force on the commencement of section 14 of the principal Act.

Note

Changes authorised by subpart 2 of Part 3 of the Legislation Act 2019 have been made in this consolidation. See the notes at the end of this consolidation for further details.

This Act is administered by the Ministry of Justice.

3 Conditions of off-licences

Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by adding the following subsections:

- (4) This section applies—
 - (a) not only to licences issued on or after the commencement of this section; but
 - (b) also to licences in force immediately before the commencement of this section.
- (5) Subsection (4) applies to avoid doubt.

Consolidation notes

1 General

This is a consolidation of the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2005 that incorporates all the amendments to that Act as at the date of the last amendment to it.
