**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:****1 Title**

This Act is the Securities Transfer Amendment Act 2007.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

**3 Principal Act amended**

This Act amends the Securities Transfer Act 1991.

**4 Effect of this Act on other Acts, etc**

- (1) Section 9(1) is amended by omitting “memorandum or articles of association” and substituting “constitution”.
  - (2) Section 9(2) is repealed.
  - (3) Section 9(5) is repealed and the following subsection substituted:

“(5) The following enactments shall be read subject to the provisions of this Act:

    - “(a) Sections 35, 39(1), and 84 of the Companies Act 1993:
    - “(b) Section 17 of the Unit Trusts Act 1960:
    - “(c) Section 45I of the Reserve Bank of New Zealand Act 1964 (as continued in force by section 84 of the Public Finance Act 1989).”
