Order

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Companies Special Investigations Order 1988.
- (2) This order shall come into force at 11 pm on 2 January 1988.

2 Act to apply to certain companies

It is hereby declared that the Companies Special Investigations Act 1958 shall apply to the companies named in Schedules 1 and 2.

3 Receiver and manager

Harold Goodman of Auckland, Chartered Accountant, is hereby appointed receiver and manager in respect of each company to which this order applies.
