Education (Funding Arrangements for Teacher Salaries) Order 1991: revoked, on 6 November 2008, by clause 3 of the Regulations Revocation Order 2008 (SR 2008/367).

PURSUANT to section 91(2) of the Education Act 1989, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

1 Title

This order may be cited as the Education (Funding Arrangements for Teachers Salaries) Order 1991.

2 Transitional period extended

The period described in section 91(1) of the Education Act 1989 is hereby extended to the 31st day of December 1994.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order defers until 1 January 1995 the compulsory bulk funding of the salaries of teachers at all State schools (which was to have started on 1 January 1992). During the period ending 31 December 1994, bulk funding of teacher salaries will occur only at schools whose Boards have decided to adopt it.
