Explanatory note

As part of the enrolment inquiry, this order closes, as at 15 July 2011, the main rolls for all electoral districts. This enables the main rolls to be printed and published as at that date. They will then be available to the public for checking.

The making of this order does not preclude the making of a subsequent order later in 2011 or the printing of a composite roll as at writ day.
