Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (1987-88 Jack Mackerel Quota) Regulations 1987.

The notice allocates to individual commercial fishermen the quotas imposed by those regulations on the taking of jack mackerel by commercial fishermen, being—

- (a) 5970 greenweight tonnes for the Part Auckland (East), Central (East) Area:
- (b) 2200 greenweight tonnes for the South East, Southland, Sub-Antarctic Area.

The unallocated portion of the quota for each area is as follows:—

- (a) 706.1 greenweight tonnes for the Part Auckland (East), Central (East) Area:

- (b) 61.8 greenweight tonnes for the South East, Southland, Sub-Antarctic Area.

The unallocated portion for each area may be taken by commercial fishermen who have not received any allocation of quota for the area or who have filled their allocations for the area.
