- 1 Title**

These regulations are the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2012.
- 2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 1 May 2012.
- 3 Principal regulations**

These regulations amend the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 (the **principal regulations**).
- 4 Regulation 3A amended (Maximum daily number of fish)**
 - (1) In regulation 3A(1), replace “and (3)” with “, (3), and (3A)”.
 - (2) In regulation 3A(1), item relating to bluenose, insert “5” in the second column.
