1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Reporting) Amendment Regulations 2003.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 2001¹ are called "the principal regulations".

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 31 March 2003.

3 Method of entering certain details on return

Regulation 36(4) of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the words "processing returns", the words "and tuna longlining catch effort returns".

- insert a reference to tuna longlining catch effort returns into regulation 36(4) (which relates to the method of entering certain details on a return); and
- substitute a new form 7 of Schedule 2 (which relates to tuna longlining catch effort returns).
