1 Title and commencement

- (1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Rock Lobster Total Allowable Commercial Catches) Notice 1999.
- (2) This notice comes into force on 1 April 1999.

2 Interpretation

In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires, all references to quota management areas are references to those areas as defined in Part 3 of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries Act 1996.

3 Total allowable commercial catches
