1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Northland Scallop Total Allowable Commercial Catch) Notice 2000.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Interpretation

In this notice, the term **Northland scallop fishery** has the meaning given to it in section 2(1) of the Fisheries Act 1996.

4 Total allowable commercial catch for Northland scallops reduced

The total allowable commercial catch for Northland scallops is reduced from 106.000 tonnes to 60.000 tonnes meatweight.

5 Revocation

The Fisheries (Northland Scallop Total Allowable Commercial Catch) Notice 1998 (SR 1998/215) is revoked.

Explanatory note
