1 Title

This notice is the Health and Safety at Work (Class Exemption—Fumigation at Marsden Point) Revocation Notice 2023.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 1 August 2023.

3 Revocation

The Health and Safety at Work (Class Exemption—Fumigation at Marsden Point) Notice 2020 (LI 2020/293) is revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 August 2023, revokes the Health and Safety at Work (Class Exemption—Fumigation at Marsden Point) Notice 2020 (the **principal notice**).

The principal notice exempts a specified class of persons from compliance with regulation 14.38(1) of the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017, which requires a minimum buffer zone to be set for any fumigation using methyl bromide.

The principal notice is being revoked as a result of the Environmental Protection Authority's decision to ban the use of methyl bromide on ships.

This notice is revoked on 29 August 2023.

Notes

1 General
