### Regulations

#### **Title** 1

- (1) These regulations are the Land Transport (Driver Licensing and Driver Testing Fees) Amendment Regulations 2001.
- (2) In these regulations, the Land Transport (Driver Licensing and Driver Testing Fees) Regulations 1999<sup>1</sup> are called "the principal regulations".
