• Babacos, casanas, cherimoyas, feijoas, loquats, persimmons, sapotes, and guavas.

This order declares the fruit specified in clause 2 to be fruit for the purposes of the Orchard Levy Act 1953. Such fruit are thereby subject to a levy payable to the New Zealand Fruitgrowers Federation Ltd. if grown in an orchard of over 4 000 m2 in area.
