#### **Regulations**

#### 1 Title

These regulations are the Passport (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2012.

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 2 November 2012.

#### 3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Passport (Fees) Regulations 1996 (the **principal regulations**).

#### 4 New regulation 7B inserted (Online fees)

After regulation 7A, insert:

#### 7B Online fees

The fees set out in Part 3 of the Schedule are payable for applications lodged online through an Internet site maintained by or on behalf of the Secretary.

#### 5 Regulation 9 replaced (Goods and services tax included)

Replace regulation 9 with:

#### 9 Goods and services tax

The fees prescribed by these regulations are expressed exclusive of any goods and services tax payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

#### 6 Schedule replaced

Replace the Schedule with the Schedule set out in the Schedule of these regulations.

#### **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect. These regulations, which come into force on 2 November 2012, amend the Passport (Fees) Regulations 1996 (the **principal regulations**).

#### The amendments—

- introduce a new fee for passport applications lodged online; and
- reduce the fee for adult passport paper applications lodged in New Zealand;
  and
- express all of the fees in the principal regulations exclusive of goods and services tax (after taking into account the 1 October 2010 goods and services tax increase).

Issued under the authority of the Legislation Act 2012. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 1 November 2012.
