1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Petroleum Products Specifications Amendment Regulations 2003.
- (2) In these regulations, the Petroleum Products Specifications Regulations 2002¹ are called "the principal regulations".

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Sampling of fuel

Regulation 8(4) of the principal regulations is amended by adding the words "within 5 working days of receiving the request".

4 Withdrawal of fuel from sale

Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the words "require the distributor", the words ", within the period of time specified by the Minister in the notice,".

5 Offences

- (1) Regulation 11(b) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression "9", and substituting the expression "8(4)".
- (2) Regulation 11(c) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression "11", and substituting the expression "10".

6 Schedule 3 amended

Schedule 3 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting from the first column under the heading "Property" the words "Viscosity (mm per second at 40°C)", and substituting the words "Viscosity (mm2 per second at 40°C)".
