Revocation of Fisheries (Southern Scallop Fishery Rotational Fishing) Notice 1999: revoked, on 6 November 2008, by clause 3 of the Regulations Revocation Order 2008 (SR 2008/367).

PURSUANT to section 313 of the Fisheries Act 1996, the chief executive of the Ministry of Fisheries by this notice, which comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, revokes the Fisheries (Southern Scallop Fishery Rotational Fishing) Notice 1998<sup>1</sup>.
